Western Australian company WebSpy has signaled its intentions of broadening its horizons from Internet and e-mail monitoring by releasing a Netflow monitoring system. Jack Andrys, CEO of WebSpy, said the FlowMonitor is a Windows-based tool that monitors output from Cisco's Netflow, which contains invaluable information about network traffic.
